- **79%** of the students stated that (55-69) % of the syllabus was covered in the class.
- **O** 97% of the students stated that teachers prepare well for the classes.

- 74.9% of the students stated that to a reasonable extent, the teachers identify their strengths and encourage them by providing right level of challenges.
- 68.4% of the students stated that usually teachers are able to identify their weaknesses and help to overcome them.

- **O 45.6%** of the students agree that the institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and quality improvement of the teaching learning process.
- **O 36.3%** of the students strongly agree that the institute/teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.
- 88.8% of the students strongly agree that teachers encourage them to participate in extra-curricular activities.
- 43.5% of the students stated that efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make them ready for placements.
